For a new Parents' Support Worker	We had already advertised for a new Inclusion Support Manager; closing date was the following week  Parent support is part of this role. We look forward to welcoming the new person after Xmas
For parent / pupil craft clubs	We have set x3 dates for the remainder of the year  Thursday 6th December 2017  Thursday 8th February 2018  Thursday 21st June 2018  We will provide the venue, refreshments and resources; parents/carers provide the supervision, organise the activities and help the children
For Parents' Forum to be better advertised	All dates have now been posted on the school's website and on the Facebook page. Dates were also advertised during the Forum meeting. We will send further reminders nearer meeting dates.
For us to monitor and improve the levels of cleaning around school	We had already undergone a change by making cleaning and caretaking accountable through daily reporting forms  We will source some quotes to replace the lino in FSU  We have appointed a line manager to oversee all cleaning
For children whose parents had not signed their reading records or those that hadn't read at home to not have to miss break times	We think reading is the most important skill a child can have to ensure they meet their potential. We will continue to provide break time reading sessions for those children who have not had the opportunity to read at home.  When they have read, we urge you to remember to sign their reading records





For more nurture support for children with Behaviour problems or Special Educational needs	<p>The Local Authority currently recognise this as a strength or the school. Although we are very happy to take more detailed requests from parents.</p> <p>We are a Thrive© school offering social and emotional support.</p> <p>We have a SENCo who ensures all SEND pupils have individual targets specific to their development. These targets are reviewed regularly in line with LA guidance</p>
For Midday Supervisors to have an incidents book to improve communication	<p>MDS already have an Incidents Book. The improvement is in making sure messages are shared. We have organised x3 sets of annual training where key issues will be reviewed and training delivered.</p> <p>Senior MDS will ensure that all and any messages are passed on within a reasonable time scale</p>
For a comments box at the main office	<p>We can do this 😊</p>
For pupils to be allowed to choose their lunch when they arrive each morning	<p>This is a longer term aim. We are unable to address this wish at the present time</p>
For prompt and easy access to school policies	<p>All policies are on the school's website and always have been. They are uploaded within 5 working days of approval at Governors or SLT.</p> <p>Please have a look. We welcome all constructive and supportive feedback</p>
For a Parent Questionnaire each term	<p>We already do this when you attend Parents' Meetings. The outcomes of the most recent questionnaire are published on the school website.</p> <p>Take a look</p> <p>We also do pupil and staff questionnaires which we share with the Local Authority</p>
For a parents social club and after-school get-togethers	<p>We think this is something for parents to organise themselves.</p>
